INFANT SAFE HAVEN LAW IN ILLINOIS

There is a symbol on the door of manned police or fire stations, a hospital or emergency care facility, or a campus police facility which shows an infant's head being held in the hand and states, Safe Babies—Safe Place— SAFE HAVEN. THE BABY MUST NOT BE HARMED and must be UNDER 30 DAYS OF AGE. Parents are given a safe way to put their child out for adoption and legal protection is given them when the newborn is brought to a manned place.
