TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Every rectory office has received a panicked phone call from a person who has been invited to serve as a godparent, or from someone newly engaged, who suddenly "needs to get confirmed." While the lack of confirmation is not an obstacle for marriage, it is for godparenting. Many are surprised that the Church seems to be looking for a kind of sacramental "seal" on one's baptism before the door opens fully to this ministry. Yet if you think about it, would you want someone to guide you to a place that he or she had not yet been? A godparent has to be someone who has "been there" and knows the way.

Although signet rings and wax seals have passed from use, our society depends on "seals of approval" ranging from certificates of quality to the familiar safety seals on medicines and foods. While Eucharist is the "seal" of the sacrament of baptism, there is a sense in which one's Christian initiation is also incomplete without confirmation. Have you been confirmed? Perhaps it's time to inquire now, before you have to make that dreaded phone call! —Rev. James Field

TESOROS DE NUESTRA TRADICIÓN

Cada oficina rectoral ha recibido una llamada telefónica de pánico de una persona que ha sido invitada a servir como padrino, o de alguien recién comprometido, que de repente “necesita ser confirmado”. Si bien la falta de confirmación no es un obstáculo para el matrimonio, sí lo es para el padrino. Muchos se sorprenden de que la Iglesia parezca estar buscando una especie de “sello” sacramental en el bautismo antes de que la puerta se abra completamente a este ministerio. Sin embargo, si lo piensas bien, ¿te gustaría que alguien te guiara a un lugar en el que aún no has estado? Un padrino tiene que ser alguien que haya “estado allí” y conozca el camino.

Aunque los anillos de sello y los sellos de cera ya no se utilizan, nuestra sociedad depende de “sellos de aprobación”, que van desde certificados de calidad hasta los conocidos sellos de seguridad de medicamentos y alimentos. Si bien la Eucaristía es el “sello” del sacramento del bautismo, en cierto sentido la iniciación cristiana también está incompleta sin la confirmación. ¿Has sido confirmado? ¡Quizás sea el momento de preguntar ahora, antes de tener que hacer esa temida llamada telefónica!
