### *PRO-LIFE*

Citizens do not have an opportunity to influence the Supreme Court in its decisions. Citizens are allowed to pray and to express their opinions on social media. Also citizens can send letters to the editors of publications expressing their opinions. Oral arguments were heard on the case for invalidating Idaho's law making abortion a crime. The federal Emergency Medical Treatment & Labor Act compels employees of emergency rooms to kill an unborn baby whose mother's health is at risk in order to stabilize the mother. Idaho's law does not allow for this exception. It expects the emergency room employees to take every precaution to save both the life of the mother and the baby. The Supreme Court stated in Dobbs that it is up to the state to regulate laws on abortion. A decision is expected in June. ----- *Life Advocacy Briefing 4/29/2024*

## Friday Facts No. 1

I want to thank everyone that attended our parent meeting in April. I also want to thank Dr. Sanderson and Mr. Domico for their presentation that evening as well. Mr. Domico shared information with me about multiage learning and I wish to share these with you each week.

I will be sharing this information on "Multiage Learning" facts you need to know. I will share several key points each week. The purpose is to make this transition and program a success. The facts or statements listed are in no particular order but are components that define the multiage classroom.

1. **Ability Grouping** - When a classroom has "Ability Grouping" it means students are worked with at the level where they need the most help or where they are challenged beyond the class's current material. This is a "Student Driven" model. No student will be taken out of their class and put into a different class for that subject. All work is done within their assigned classroom driven by the teacher. Ex. an advanced 3rd grade student is not placed in a 5th grade room for that subject. The material is brought to them in the 3rd grade room. Likewise, a struggling student is not placed in a lower grade to accommodate. The work is brought to them.

2. Our **'Specials'** will remain in tact - Physical Education, Music, Art, and Library. Our athletic program will remain in tact.

3. Our classroom groupings are: **Preschool will be full day (with the option of a half day) and grouped 3 year olds and 4 year olds, Kindergarten will be a stand alone class, 1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8 will be grouped accordingly.**

4. We have had multiage concepts in our school for many years, meeting student needs. This past year **6th and 7th were together for Religion, Art, and Physical Education.**

5. This year, we have started professional development for our teachers. May 13th, our staff visited Sr. Mary in Kickapoo and St. Edward in Chillicothe. This was intended to give teachers a first hand observation and a chance to ask questions. We also had Dara Carr from the Regional Office of Education do a presentation on May 23 about multiage learning. I hope you have a great weekend!
