PRO-LIFE

The Family Resource Council in March of 2024 has advised the American people that the UNITED NATIONS’ WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO), AN UNELECTED INTERNATIONAL BODY OF BUREAUCRATS UNACCOUNTABLE TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, is trying to gain more power by creating a “global pandemic treaty and contributing over “300 amendments.” The current administration asked for this change to an agreement because it would not require ratification by the US Senate and could be adopted without discussion. There are many concerns. ONE IS FUNDING ABORTION ON DEMAND; financial obligations not known to taxpayers; intellectual property rights and free speech would be in jeopardy; and a health philosophy which equals human health to that of plants and animals would be established. It is scheduled to be voted on this month. Please pray that the Agreement does not get signed by the United States.
