PRO LIFE NEWS-

The media is spreading news that the voters want Roe vs Wade back. Susan B. Anthony polling shows guite a different result: 69% support laws restricting abortions in the first 3 months; 60% oppose funding of abortions by taxpayers; 61% disagree with the safety of abortion drugs being sent through the mail without medical supervision; 83% support pregnancy centers which provide "vital material, medical, and educational support to mothers."

(The cause of death recently of the two women who had taken abortion drugs received through the mail with no medical doctor's supervision, had nothing to do with the abortion law in Georgia as the media ——Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life America Polling Memo by Frank Cannon had stated.)
