



HR-4123, The Parental Notification & Intervention Act has been pending in the House Judiciary Committee since June. As you may recall it, it requires an abortionist who receives federal funding to notify the parents of a minor who seeks an abortion. It also requires a 4-day waiting period. HR-792 Child Interstate Abortion Act, also is still pending in the House Judiciary Committee. It requires notification of parents of a minor who crosses state lines for an abortion and if a minor is transported from a state that requires parental notice to a state that has no such notification requirement.
