PRO LIFE NEWS—

A leaked photo from Army briefing at Fort Liberty, formerly Fort Bragg, North Carolina, the largest military installation in the world, revealed pro-life activities and groups as terrorist threats. Those named were the National Right to Life and Operation Rescue. The President of National Right to Life believes the slides are indicative of a wider atmosphere to "vilify pro-life people as anti-woman bigots."

Answers were demanded by the House Armed Services Committee and it is absurd that protected constitutional activities qualify them as terrorists. The training material shown implied opposition to pregnancy centers' counseling and opposition to pro-life advocacy. The slides also indicated that "CHOOSE LIFE" license plates which are approved in 34 states and D.C., indicate a terrorist threat.

The Department of Defense stated that the training slides had been prepared by a local garrison employee and were not vetted by the appropriate authorities. A correction was to be issued to all servicemen viewing such slides and appropriate discipline would be issued to those responsible.
