The F.A.C.E. Act, the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrance Act, an unconscionable act, led to 6 pro-life advocates being arrested on federal felony charges for a sit-in in an abortion clinic in Nashville TN. F.A.C.E. was enacted to ensure access to churches & pro-life pregnancy centers but is being used to prosecute pro-life activists & not to penalize those who vandalized 229 churches & hundreds of pro-life pregnancy centers. Prayers for Pro-Life—We are participating in the "Church Adopt a Day to Pray" for the 40 Days of Life campaign which will begin March 7—April 4. We will be praying on Thursdays after a period of silence following the King's Nation Prayer during the Holy Hour at Adoration in Woodhull. A prayer bag will be provided which includes information on the upcoming Supreme Court hearing on the FDA'S expansion of the abortion pill & the Illinois state legislation Euthanasia, as well as a prayer card. Our combined prayers are needed for the nation & our state.

When you accidentally drop the Holy Eucharist on the floor while receiving it: remain calm; remain where you are, to protect the area; inform a(the) minister. S/he will offer you another Host – respond Amen, as usual.



They will pick up the dropped Host and take it to the Altar (or place it on the Altar Server's Communion Paten, have a purificator obtained, and place it over the area because some small particles may remain on the floor; the cloth will remind the ministers, altar servers, communicants/congregation where to avoid stepping.

Following the Rite of Holy Communion/Mass, a minister will purify the area.
