California has the Parental Exclusion Policies statewide in all public schools. They force teachers to withhold information about children from their parents about gender transition. This is not allowing parents to know what is going on in school, such as, the teacher has to call a male student who wants to be a girl, by female pronouns and a female name of his choosing. On the other hand, the teacher has to refer to him by his male name and use male pronouns when discussing school matters with his parents. Over 18,600 schools are following such policies. The Thomas More Society attorneys are in court to ban such dangerous policies against basic parental rights and the safety of children, as well as teachers' First amendment rights. Pope Francis has declared that 2025 will be celebrated as a Jubilee year of Pilgrims of Hope. He has invited local Bishops to open that Year of Jubilee in their Diocese on Sunday, December 29, 2024, the Feast of the Holy Family. Bishop Tylka invites you to join him as he celebrates the 10:30 AM Mass at the Cathedral of St Mary, Peoria to open the Year of the Jubilee. There will be a pre-Mass ritual that will begin at 10:00 SM at the Spalding Pastoral Center which will include a Gospel reading, a reading from the Papal Bull for the Jubilee Year, and a procession to the Cathedral. The ritual will continue at the beginning of the Mass with a showing of the Cross with the relic of the True and a Sprinkling Rite. All who wish are invited to join us for that ritual.
