Cal Castrow is a faith-filled Christian, age 63, who was arrested for being a peaceful protester for the unborn and charged by the current administration's DOJ with violating the FACE Act (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrance) and adding anti-KuKluxKlan Act charges to add more prison time. He has been sent to the Federal Correctional Institute in Thomson IL known for its history of homicides, assaults, and rampant abuse. The Thomas More Society attorneys are fighting to secure his freedom.
