



Mike Johnson, House Speaker, has stated that defunding Planned Parenthood and making the Hyde Amendment permanent are issues he will support. The Hyde Amendment banned use of federal funds to pay for abortions except in the case of the life of the mother or in cases of incest or rape. IN THE PAST IT HAD TO BE RENEWED EVERY YEAR.
