An American psychologist and researcher, Pricilla Coleman, studied the effects of abortion on3/4 of as million women and found that 81% of women had much more negative health effects and four times greater occurrences of suicide than those who brought their babies to term or were never pregnant. These women studied experienced 2.5 times greater attempts at suicide, 2.1 times greater substance and/or alcohol abuse, 1.4 greater rates of depression, and 1.3 greater rates of anxiety than those who had carried their babies to term or were never pregnant.
